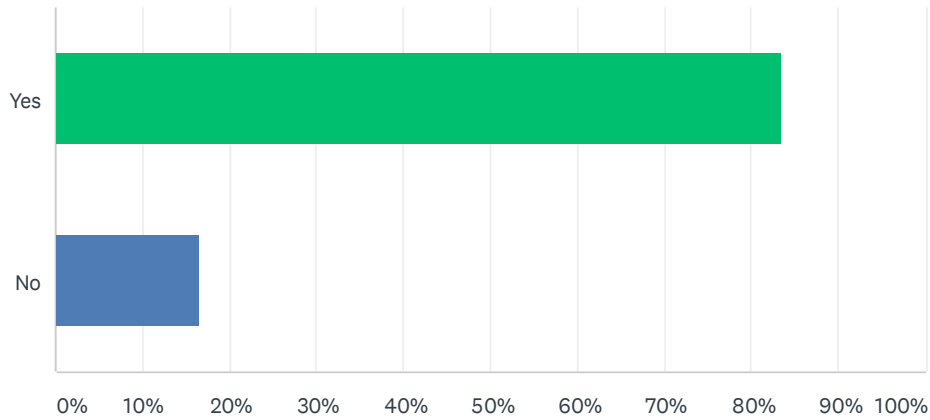


Q1 Does you child have access to a personal device with internet connection for on-line and remote learning that they could use for 6 hours per day?

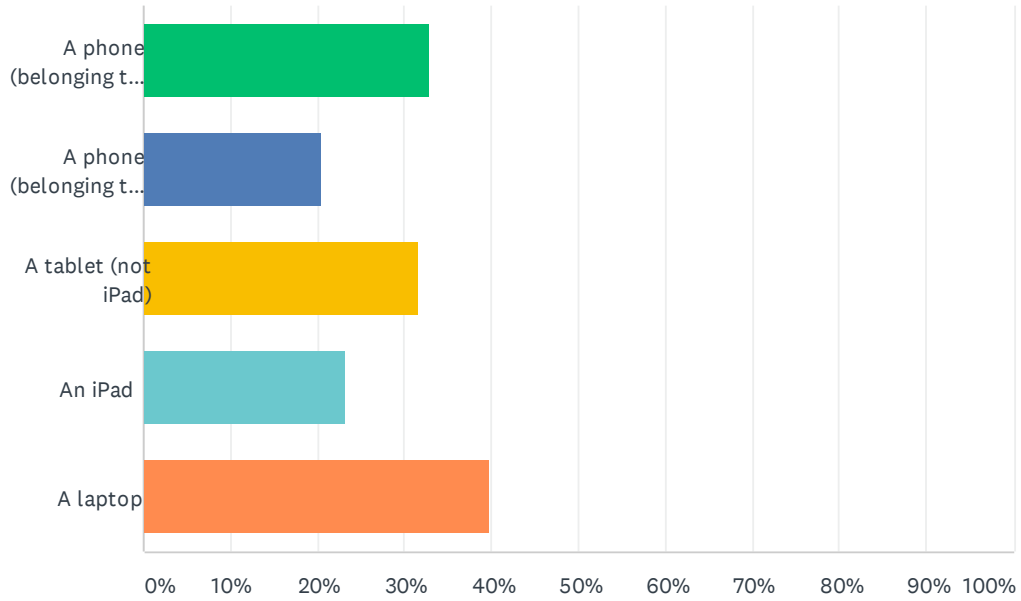

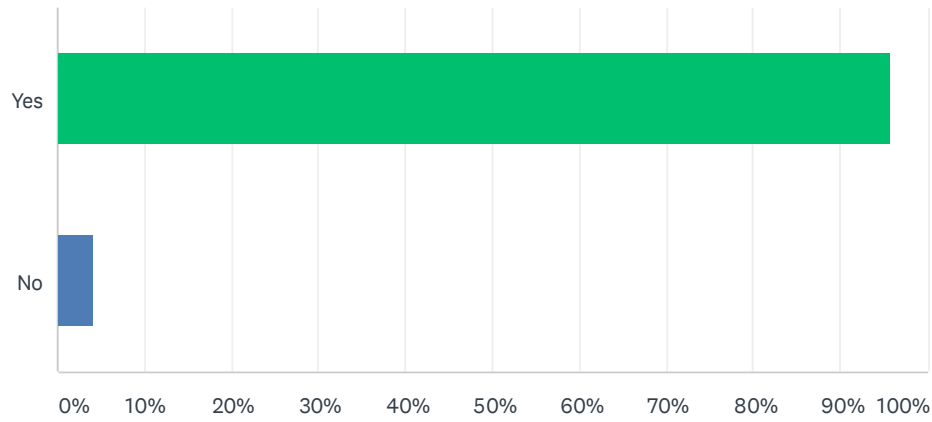

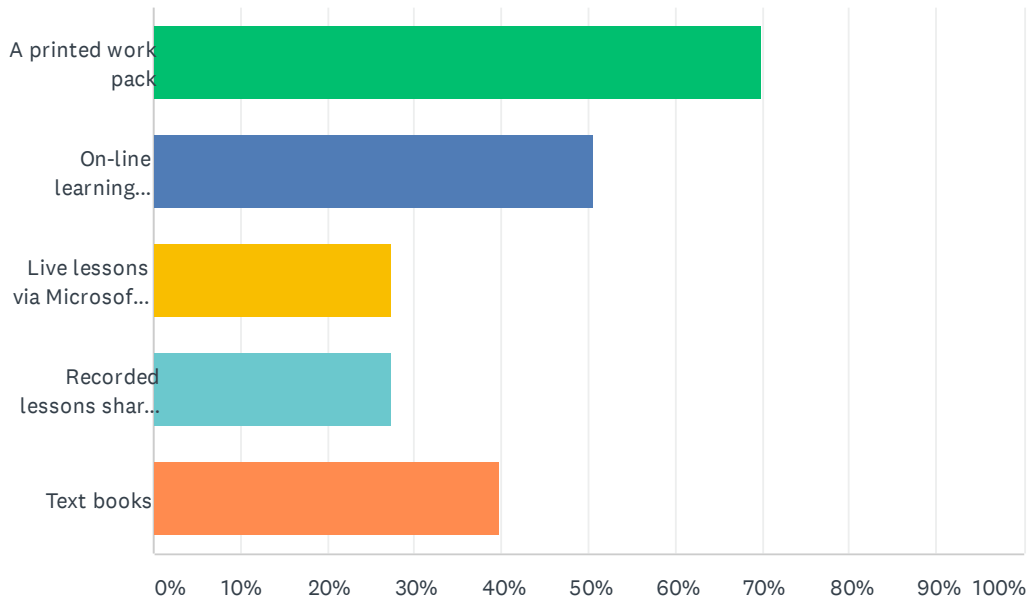

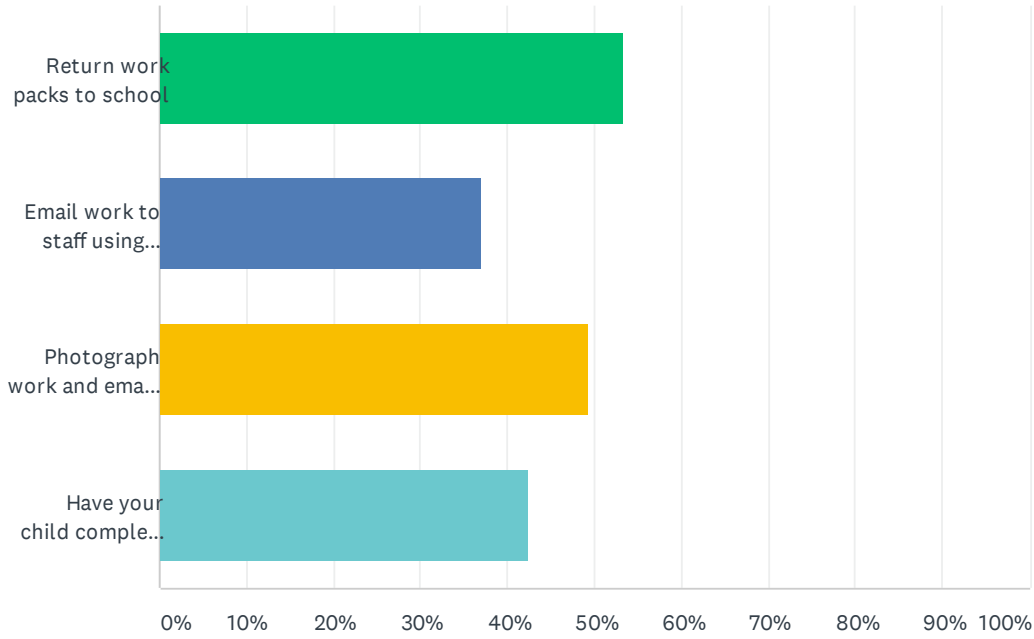
